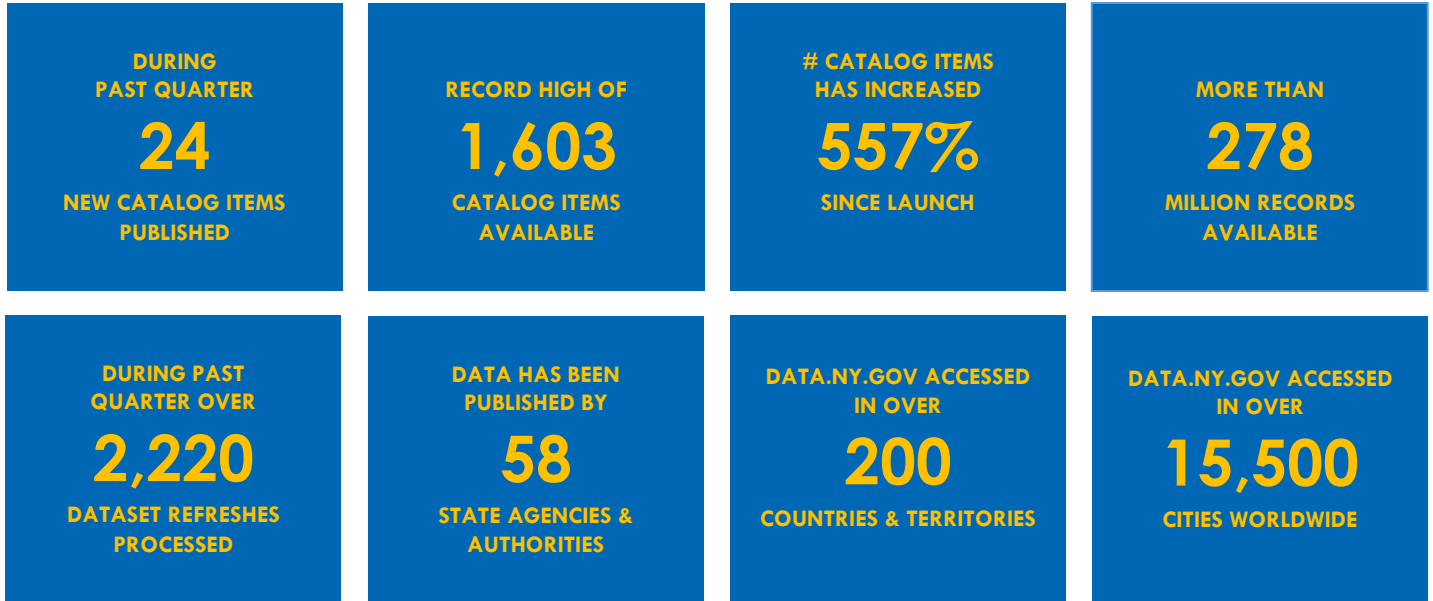




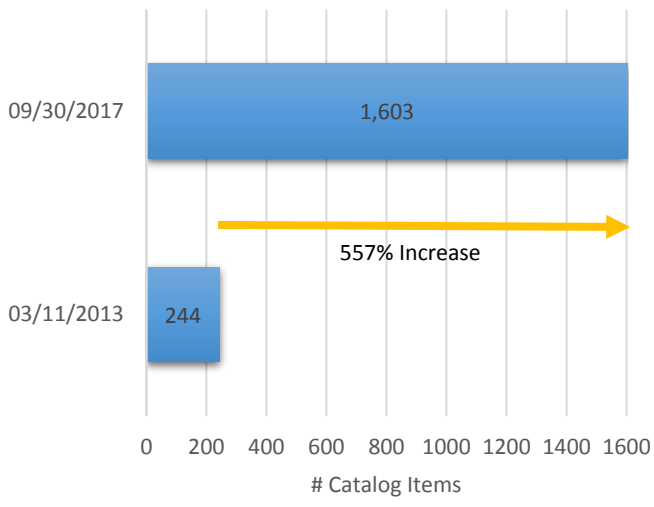
## Open NY Fast Facts



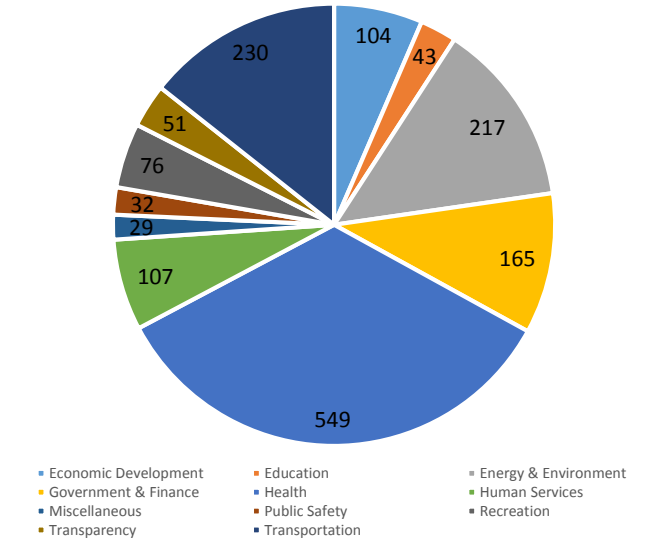
## Highlights

- [Environmental Remediation Sites](#) are areas being remediated under one of the Department of Environmental Conservation's remedial programs, including State Superfund and Brownfield Cleanup. This dataset contains records of the sites which have been remediated or are being managed by the agency. Each site record includes: administrative information, including site name, classification, unique site code, site location, and site owner(s), Institutional and Engineering Controls implemented at the site, and wastes known or thought to be disposed at the site.
- Information on solar power in New York State is now interactive! Check out the interactive charts, graphs, and maps for more than 80,000 residential, small commercial, and commercial / industrial solar electric projects now available on the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority's [website](#). The interactive dashboard will replace the original Open NY charts, graphs, data lens, and filtered views. The solar electric dataset will remain on Open NY; the charts, graphs, data lens, and filtered views associated with the solar electric dataset will be removed from the Open NY website on December 1, 2017. Users are encouraged to utilize the interactive solar dashboard on the NYSERDA website in conjunction with the solar electric Open NY dataset. - The Department of Health has been working to consolidate the data in several datasets and identify redundant items for deprecation. Please see the list at the end of this Update for more details.

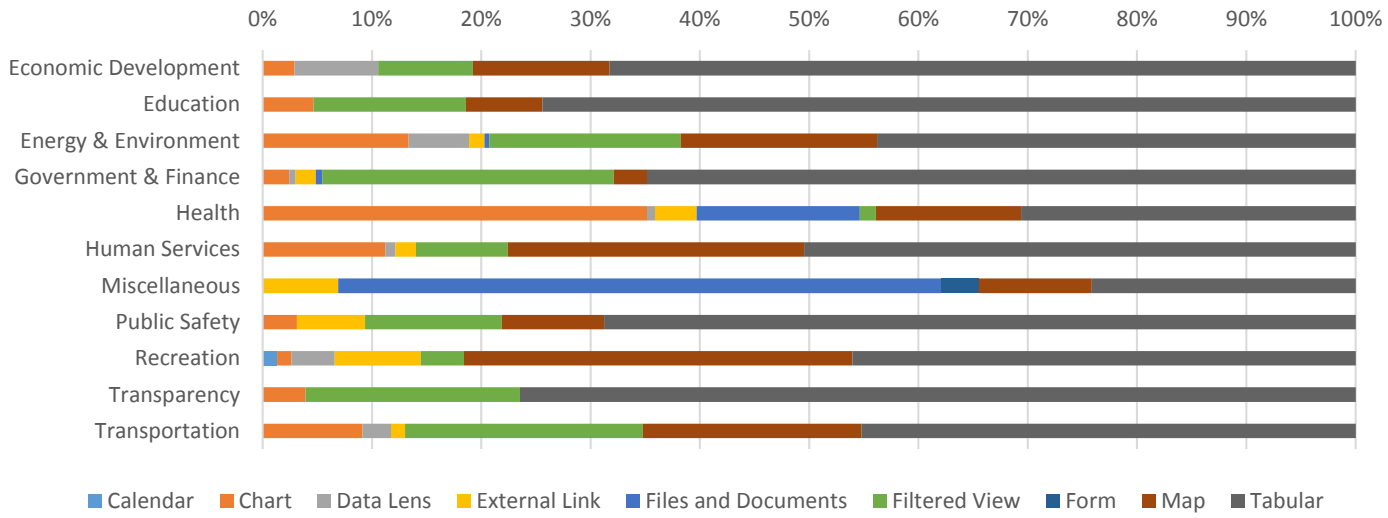
### Open Data NY Growth



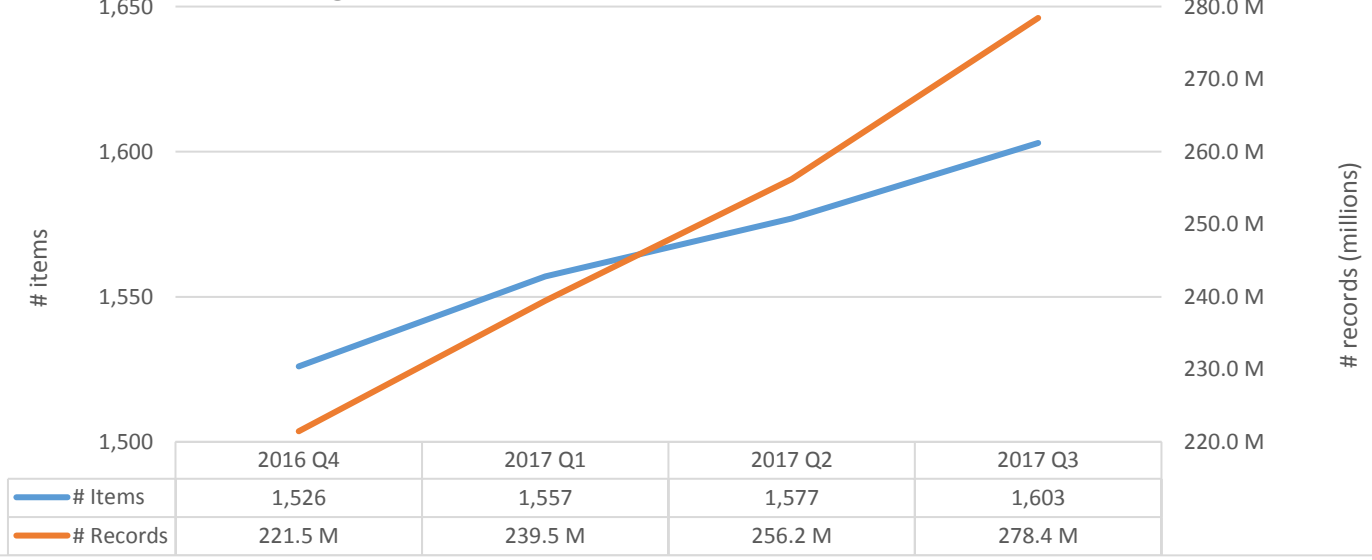
### Catalog Items by Category

## Catalog items slated for removal

When [Health Data NY](#) originally rolled-out in March, 2013, several items were published to highlight the ability to access tabular dataset information via an Application Programming Interface (API). Since then, the API functionality “baked into” every Open NY dataset has matured, becoming more approachable and accessible via the documentation provided on each dataset’s page. As these API-specific items are now redundant, they will be removed on October 31, 2017. Following is a list of each item and its link along with the link where the data is available.
