Tank Location	Text	Physical location of tank: Aboveground-contact w/soil Aboveground-contact w/impervious barrier Aboveground-no contact (on saddles, legs, stilts, rack or cradle, etc.) Tank with 10% or more below ground Underground including vaulted with no access for inspection Aboveground in Subterranean Vault w/ access for inspections

Close Date	Date	Date a tank was permanently closed. If unknown, the date is blank.
Material Name	Text	Common Name of Substance in Tank
Percent	Numeric	The percentage of hazardous substance material in tank. (Applies to Chemical Bulk Storage (CBS) tanks only) (There is the capacity to input multi - material percentages for each tank.)
Expiration Date	Date	Expiration date of the facility's registration certificate or license.
Site Status Name	Text	Current status of the facility: Active - Currently regulated under one of the Bulk Storage Programs. Unregulated/Closed - A facility that does not meet the thresholds for quantity or product type for regulation under one of the Bulk Storage Programs or has been closed by the DEC for management purposes. For example, to eliminate duplicate facilities. Unregistered - A facility that is not currently registered but meets the requirements for regulation under one of the Bulk Storage Programs; a PBS regulated facility located in a delegated county*; or a facility which is not regulated which submitted a Bulk Storage registration application which was returned unprocessed. Inactive– Facility is not operating (verified by inspection or other reliable means) but closure not completed/verified.
UTMX	Numeric	X coordinate (latitude), represented in UTM (Universal Transverse Mercator) units. (Note: NYS is zone 18 for UTM)
UTMY	Numeric	Y coordinate (longitude), represented in UTM (Universal Transverse Mercator) units. (Note: NYS is zone 18 for UTM)
