

DMV-Reportable Traffic Ticket Convictions: 4 Year Window Data

Data Dictionary

Data Label	Data Type	Data Description
Conviction Description	Text	The violation for which the driver was convicted. This is not always the same charge as was on the corresponding ticket.
Year of Conviction	Numeric	Year in which the conviction was recorded.
Month of Conviction	Text	Month in which the conviction was recorded.
Age on Violation Date	Numeric	Age of the driver at the time of the traffic violation. This is sometimes unknown and will display a blank in that case.
Sex	Text	Sex of the driver. M = male. F = female. This is sometimes unknown and will display a blank in that case.
License Class on Violation Date	Text	Class(es) of license held by the driver at the time of the traffic violation; combinations are merged (e.g., DM is class D and class M licensed). This is unknown for out-of-state drivers. Some drivers are unlicensed at the time of the violation and will display a blank in that case. License class descriptions can be found at http://dmv.ny.gov/forms/mv500c.pdf . Additional class codes: ID = identification card, non-license; PER = permit, non-license; ORL = original non-license; N = no longer issued license type.
Court Name	Text	The name of the court that disposed the ticket.
